From Springfield, MA area and points North, take Interstate 91 South:

Take I-91 South toward Hartford. Continue through Hartford on I-91 South, towards New Haven. Take exit 27 for Airport Rd toward Brainard Rd. Turn right onto Airport Rd, travel 0.3 mi. Take the 2nd left onto Wethersfield Ave. Destination will be on the right in 0.4 mi.

From Danbury, CT , Interstate 84 East:

Take Interstate 84 towards Hartford. Take exit to I-91 South and follow directions above.

From New Haven, CT area and points south, Interstate 91 North:

Take I-91 north to exit 27, Brainard Rd toward Airport Rd/Brainard/Airport , travel 0.5 mi. Turn left onto Brainard Rd, travel 0.2 mi. Turn left onto Airport Rd, travel 0.6 mi. Take the 2nd left onto Wethersfield Ave. Destination will be on the right in 0.4 mi.

From Sturbridge, MA areas , Interstate 84 West:

Take Interstate 84 towards Hartford. Continue onto CT-15 S (signs for I-91 S/ Charter Oak Bridge/N Y. City), travel 1.1 mi. Continue onto US-5 S, travel 1.5 mi. Take exit 87 for Brainard Rd toward Airport Rd Turn left onto Brainard Rd, travel 0.2 mi. Turn left onto Airport Rd, travel 0.6 mi. Take the 2nd left onto Wethersfield Ave. Destination will be on the right in 0.4 mi.
